## ASPCA Provides \$20K Grant to Southeast Llama Rescue, Inc. for MLAS Rescue Travel Expenses

Southeast Llama Rescue, Inc. (SELR) is pleased to announce that our organization is the recipient of a generous \$20,000 grant from the ASPCA. SELR worked in collaboration with the Camelid Rescue Coalition (CRC) to rescue hundreds of llamas that were without adequate food and care at the sanctuary near Hot Springs, Montana. The CRC is comprised of SELR in conjunction with Northeast Llama Rescue, Inc., Southwest Llama Rescue, Inc., Llama Association of North America's Llama Lifeline Committee (LANA Lifeline) and several other llama associations.

The ASPCA grant will help to defray the more than \$50K spent to transport the llamas from the Montana sanctuary to foster facilities throughout the country. These llamas will ultimately be offered for adoption.

Donations are still needed to assist with food and veterinary costs for these llamas.
